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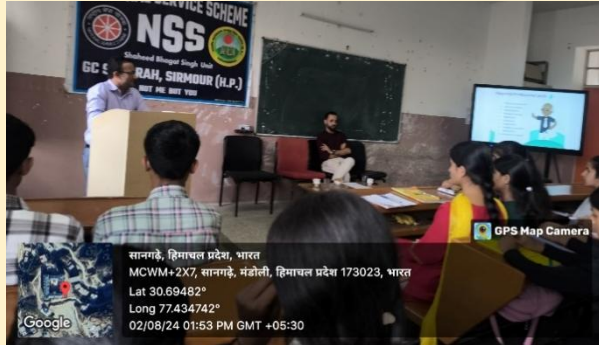

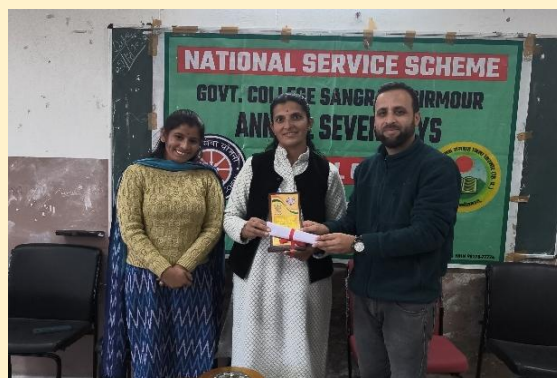

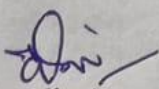
The objective of the session was to guide students in understanding core scientific concepts and to provide tips on how to effectively prepare for competitive examinations

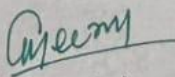

a. Two Sessions on Digital Entrepreneurship and Market Job Opportunity



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Career Guidance and Digital Entrepreneurship Sessions

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Government College Sangrah, in collaboration with the Career Guidance and Placement Cell, organized two significant sessions aimed at enhancing students' employability skills, digital competencies, and understanding of emerging self-employment opportunities. These sessions were designed to bridge the gap between academic learning and professional readiness by equipping students with relevant knowledge of the contemporary job market and digital entrepreneurship. Both sessions received active participation from the students and proved highly beneficial for their career advancement.

Session 01: Expert Lecture on Digital Entrepreneurship

Under this session, an experienced employee from UCO Bank was invited to deliver a comprehensive lecture on "Digital Entrepreneurship." A total of 57 students participated in the session. The resource person introduced the concept of digital entrepreneurship and explained how digital platforms today provide young individuals with opportunities to start their ventures with minimal investment. He elaborated on emerging areas such as e-commerce, digital payment systems, online services, freelancing, content creation, and social media marketing. The speaker provided detailed insights into the digital payment ecosystem—including UPI, mobile banking, and net banking—and highlighted the importance of cyber-security and safe online transactions. He explained the significance of financial literacy, proper account management, and the availability of bank-supported schemes such as MUDRA loans, MSME schemes, and start-up assistance for aspiring entrepreneurs. Students were also informed about digital branding, customer management, online market expansion, and essential digital tools required to run an online business effectively. b. Session on Bank Loan and Govt. Self Help Group Schemes in HP



Report on the Session: Bank Loans and Government Self-Help Group Schemes in Himachal Pradesh

Government College Sangrah, under the guidance of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and in collaboration with the Career Guidance and Placement Cell and the NSS Unit of the college, organized an insightful and career-oriented session on the theme "Bank Loan Facilities and Government Self-Help Group (SHG) Schemes in Himachal Pradesh." The session was held on 27 June 2025 and featured Mr. Harsh, Area Manager of Planet Earth Society, Paonta Sahib, as the distinguished speaker. The objective of this programme was to provide students with essential knowledge about financial assistance programmes, government-supported welfare schemes, and community-based entrepreneurial opportunities.



The speaker began the session with an overview of the significance of Self-Help Groups in the socio-economic development of rural and semi-urban regions. He explained how SHGs function as organized groups that cultivate savings habits, encourage mutual support, and provide easy access to micro-credit facilities. Mr. Harsh highlighted that SHGs in Himachal Pradesh have played a transformative role in women's empowerment, enabling them to start small-scale income-generating activities and improve their family's financial stability. He discussed the structure, financial functioning, leadership roles, and sustainability mechanisms of SHGs in detail.

Following this, Mr. Harsh elaborated on the various bank loan facilities available for individuals, entrepreneurs, and SHG members. He provided detailed information on micro-loans, agricultural and allied sector loans, small business loans, youth start-up loans, and SHG-linked credit facilities. Special emphasis was placed on government-backed schemes such as MUDRA Loans (Shishu, Kishor, Tarun), PMEGP, NRLM credit linkages, and Himachal Pradesh specific welfare and entrepreneurship programmes. Students were guided through the



eligibility criteria, documentation requirements, credit assessment, loan application procedures, and repayment norms associated with these facilities.

A key highlight of the session was the explanation of how Planet Earth Society works collaboratively with banks, local governance bodies, and community groups to strengthen financial literacy and entrepreneurship development. Mr. Harsh shared information on training workshops, capacity-building initiatives, and project preparation support that enable beneficiaries to create bankable proposals for self-employment ventures. He also presented inspiring success stories from Sirmour district where SHGs and young entrepreneurs have successfully availed loans and government assistance to establish sustainable income sources.



The session included an engaging interactive segment where students asked questions related to interest rates, loan collateral requirements, SHG formation processes, repayment challenges, and practical obstacles faced by first-time entrepreneurs. Mr. Harsh responded to all queries with clarity, helping students gain a deeper understanding of financial planning and credit management. The NSS volunteers, in particular, actively participated by connecting the discussion with various community-centric activities they undertake.

In conclusion, the session proved highly informative and impactful, significantly broadening students' awareness of financial assistance mechanisms and SHG-related opportunities in Himachal Pradesh. It aligned closely with the college's commitment to promoting financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and community development. IQAC, the Career Guidance and Placement Cell, and the NSS Unit expressed their appreciation to Planet Earth Society and Mr. Harsh for delivering a meaningful and practical session. The programme successfully motivated students to explore self-employment avenues and empowered them with the knowledge required to navigate the evolving financial and entrepreneurial landscape.

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c. Solar Panel Training: One Day Workshop



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Report on One-Day Workshop on Solar Panel Training

Organized by: Career Guidance and Placement Cell & IQAC, Government College Sangrah

Participants: 39 Students

Government College Sangrah organized a one-day *Solar Panel Training Workshop* under the joint coordination of the Career Guidance and Placement Cell, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), and the NSS Unit. The workshop aimed to provide students with hands-on knowledge of solar energy systems, installation procedures, and the growing employment opportunities in the renewable energy sector. A total of 39 students actively participated in this practical and skill-oriented training programme, which proved highly beneficial in enhancing their technical understanding and employability skills.



The workshop was conducted by three experienced trainers—Mr. Kamal, Mr. Sunil, and Mr. Virender—who have extensive expertise in solar technology and field-level installation processes. The session began with an introduction to the importance of renewable energy in the present global context. The trainers elaborated on how solar power has emerged as a crucial alternative energy source and how Himachal Pradesh, with its favourable climatic conditions, holds immense potential for solar energy adoption. They emphasized the role of trained technicians and engineers in meeting the increasing demand for solar installation and maintenance services.

The trainers then introduced students to different types of solar panels, including monocrystalline, polycrystalline, and thin-film panels, explaining their characteristics, efficiency levels, and suitability for various environments. Students were also familiarized with critical components of a solar photovoltaic (PV) system such as inverters, charge controllers, batteries, mounting structures, and wiring systems. The trainers explained how these components work together to convert sunlight into usable electrical energy, and how proper configuration ensures system efficiency and longevity.



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A major portion of the workshop focused on **practical demonstrations**, where students learned about step-by-step installation procedures. Trainers guided them through mounting panel structures, connecting PV modules, aligning panels for maximum sunlight exposure, and ensuring proper wiring connections. Safety protocols for installation and maintenance—including handling electrical components, preventing system overload, and routine inspection techniques—were also explained. The hands-on exposure provided the students with a deeper understanding of the technical requirements and real-world challenges of solar panel installation.



The session additionally highlighted the rising demand for solar technicians and the various career paths available in the renewable energy industry. The trainers discussed job opportunities in government schemes, private companies, rural electrification projects, and self-employment avenues. Students were informed about the procedures for setting up small-scale solar enterprises, applying for relevant certifications, and accessing government subsidies and financial assistance schemes that promote solar adoption in Himachal Pradesh.



During the interactive segment, students asked questions related to installation costs, efficiency variations, maintenance requirements, and long-term sustainability of solar systems. The trainers addressed each query in detail, motivating students to pursue technical training in renewable energy fields. NSS volunteers participated actively, linking the workshop outcomes



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with community service initiatives such as promoting clean energy awareness in nearby villages. In conclusion, the workshop proved to be highly effective in strengthening students' technical competencies and introducing them to the practical aspects of solar energy systems. The collaboration between IQAC, the Career Guidance and Placement Cell, and the NSS Unit ensured that the event was well-organized and goal-oriented. The workshop successfully enhanced the students' awareness of sustainable energy and equipped them with skills relevant to the modern green energy sector.
